Instructions

Compare two things, people, ideas, or events using the resources in this Pack. Think about how the two are the same. Then, contrast them by thinking about how they are different. What can you learn about each thing, person, idea, or event by studying them side by side?

Questions

Choose two resources to compare. Which two resources will you use?

Closely examine the two resources you picked. Find two to three details that illustrate how these resources are similar. Describe these similarities.

Now review the resources again. Find two to three details that illustrate how these resources are different from one another. Describe these differences.

Are these two resources more alike or more different? Explain your thoughts.

Is there a third resource in the Pack that could be compared to the first two? Which resource is it?

Reflect on the process of comparing and contrasting. Did you learn something new by examining these resources side by side? Explain what you learned.
